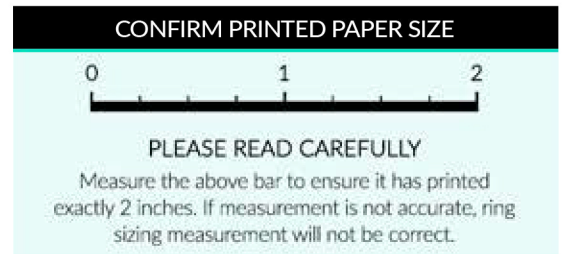


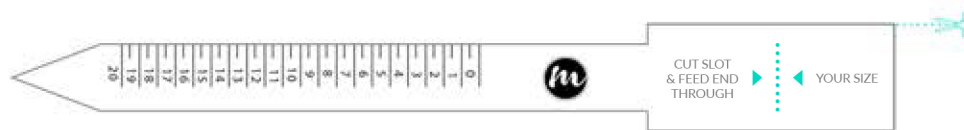
HELPFUL HINTS

- Before printing, make sure the page scaling option is set to none in the print dialogue box.
- Once printed, use a ruler to confirm the printed paper size in the box on the right.
- Select one of the options below to find your true ring size.



1 - DIY: RING SIZER

1. Cut out the ring sizer below and create a slit by making a small cut on the dotted line next to "YOUR SIZE".
2. Wrap the sizer around the widest part of the intended finger with the number visible to you.
3. Insert the pointed end through the slit in the sizer. Make sure you pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to display the accurate size.
4. The number that lines up with the slit is your ring size!



2 - MEASURE YOUR RING

1. Select a ring that perfectly fits your finger.
2. Place your ring on the chart below. Fit your ring to the circle that matches its inner perimeter. Make sure the circle's black line is visible within the ring's inner perimeter - and you found your ring size!
